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Readers wishing to submit manuscripts for publication or books for review should refer to the inside back cover for further information.

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Submission of high quality articles in any area of mathematics education research is invited. Empirical and non-empirical research reports are acceptable, and research reviews should offer a creative synthesis of work in a specific field of enquiry. Both full-length articles (up to 9000 words) and shorter reports (up to 3000 words) are welcome.

Manuscripts should be prepared with minimal formatting - the default settings on word-processing packages should be used for headings. Tables and figures should be included in the text. These must be no bigger than the text block size of the printed journal page. English (Australian) spelling should be used. APA (5th ed.) is the referencing style adopted by the journal. Exceptions to the style and details about spelling and punctuation requirements are found in the MERGA Publications Guide - available from the Editor.

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
