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Submission of high quality articles in any area of mathematics education research is invited. Empirical and non-empirical research reports are acceptable, and research reviews should offer a creative synthesis of work in a specific field of enquiry. Both full-length articles (up to 9000 words) and shorter reports (up to 3000 words) are welcome.

Manuscripts should be prepared with minimal formatting – the default settings on word-processing packages should be used for headings. If possible, tables and figures should be included in the text. OR included on separate pages at the end of the article. English (Australia) spelling should be used. APA (5th ed.) is the referencing style adopted by the journal. Exceptions to the style and details about spelling and punctuation requirements are found in the MERGA Publications Guide – available from the Editor, <Helen.Fogasz@education.monash.edu.au>.

Two versions of each article should be submitted: one full version, and one blinded version in which all direct and indirect references to the author(s) should be eliminated. The names of all authors, affiliations and email addresses as well as a 100-word abstract should be included with submitted articles. Manuscripts should be sent as email attachments to the Editor: <Helen.Fogasz@education.monash.edu.au>. If this is not possible, five hard copies can be mailed to Dr. Helen Fogasz, Editor, Mathematics Education Research Journal, Faculty of Education, Monash University, Wellington Road, Victoria 3800, Australia. Hard copies should be printed on A4 paper using a 12pt font, and 1.5 line-spacing. In a covering message, the name of the author with whom the editor will correspond should be clearly indicated. For each author, name, affiliation, postal address, and email address must also be provided. The authors must certify that the manuscript has not been submitted for publication in other journals. Only articles that differ substantially from previously published work should be submitted.
